The Episcopal Ordination of Bishop-Elect Gerard Bradley will take place at 12.30pm in St George's Cathedral on Monday 2nd February.

St GEORGE'S CATHEDRAL SECOND COLLECTION 25th JANUARY

In many respects, St George's Cathedral serves as a spiritual home and 'beehive' for Catholic evangelisation and mission across the Archdiocese of Southwark.

St George's Cathedral is entirely reliant upon the generosity of its parishioners, volunteers and the Archdiocese of Southwark to keep its doors open.
